
# SOAP JOURNAL

## How to SOAP



Scripture – Watch the Video and READ the verse of the week. Try reading it from a few versions. Write the verses or draw what happened on your SOAP under S.



Observation – What is the verse saying? How are people feeling? What is Jesus or God doing and saying? Why?



Application – God is everywhere and always with us. You can be anywhere and be with God. You can talk with God anytime. Where are places you like to be with God? How can you remember to look and listen to God everywhere you go?



Prayer – God is with us! Write out your desires and prayers of what you'd love to see Jesus do in you, in your family and in our world.

## Wk 7

33 Anyone who accepts his testimony can affirm that God is true. 34 For he is sent by God. He speaks God's words, for God gives him the Spirit without limit. 35 The Father loves his Son and has put everything into his hands. 36 And anyone who believes in God's Son has eternal life.

READ the story of John the Baptist pointing to Jesus – the One who is greater. (Luke 3:22-36) Write the verses or draw what happened on your SOAP under S.

What are the verses saying? Imagine being by the lake. You're hanging out with John the Baptist, you think he's an amazing man to follow and suddenly you're being pointed to another.



Who do you listen to in your life? Are there some people who are trustworthy and others who aren't? What do you believe about Jesus? What do you think this eternal friendship and life might look like?




As you pray today, put your faith/belief in Jesus. He is greater and holds everything in His hands.





Cut out and glue some of these beliefs in the soil. Watch them grow! They are seeds of faith, true things we can believe about us and God.



#### **Activity:** Trust Walking

This activity only works when you commit to being trustworthy: keeping true to your word through your actions. Partner up and take it in turns to be blindfolded while your partner takes you by the hand around the house or backyard. Swap over and feel what it is like to believe. Even though you can't see what's happening, you believe that your family member will keep you safe.

#### Discussion

Share about a time when a friend has not been trustworthy with you. What might be most exciting about believing in God? What is your favourite promise from Jesus?

READ the story of Jesus with the Woman at the Well (Luke 4:1-30) Write the verses from above or ones that jump out to you or draw what happened on your SOAP.



What are the verses saying? Imagine if you were the woman. You know you are not a 'good person', that's why you're out getting water while no one else is nearby. You meet this man who is talking about water but He is offering you something that could change your life! What does she say/do?



What does it mean to have a "bubbling spring within"?



Chat with God about life with Him, how you feel broken and how you would love to be restored.

Find seven (7) differences





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Activity: Mosaic

Cut up some wrapping paper or used cards you've been saving. Glue these broken parts to make something new – your favourite animal, flower or landscape.

#### Discussion

Name something that is more beautiful when it has been broken and put back together or restored? Why?

READ the story of the disciples chatting with Jesus. (Luke 4: 31-42) Write the verses or draw what happened on your SOAP under S.

The disciples have totally missed what has just happened with the woman at the well. She has met Jesus, the One who restores her and is now a friend. They are talking about lunch. What is Jesus pointing out to them?



Do you sometimes miss what God is doing in the world? Are there things that are on your mind that make you worried? What might it look like if you believed that Jesus loves you and will look after you, so now you can look to being part of what God is doing?



Offer your worries and concerns to God. He hears you and cares for you.



Activity: Three Things

You can play this around the dinner table. Each family member focuses on what is around you. Name 3 things you can see, hear and feel. Ramp up the difficulty – each seen, heard and felt thing can only be used once.

#### Discussion

What are some things that make you worry.
What are some things that make you smile?
What things might Jesus do in your friends life
that would make them smile?

READ the story of The Official (Luke 4:43-54) Write the verses from above or ones that jump out to you or draw what happened on your SOAP.

What are the verses saying? Imagine knowing that something bad is happening in your life and you can't do anything about it. This made the Official look to Jesus and what He is able to do. Write or draw what happens.



What do you think of the Official's belief in Jesus? Have you ever had faith in Jesus like this? How do you think his action of going home and trusting changed the Officials life? What does it do when you act on what Jesus promises you?



Chat with God about some actions that might encourage you to have hope and continue to trust.

Directions to Grow Your

Belief - Faith - Action

- Believe that Jesus is who He says He is
- Trust that Jesus has done what He said He has done
- Follow Jesus' life example and teachings
